1. THE POST-DOCTORAL PROGRAM

The FGV Law School is inviting applications for one post-doctoral position at the Global Fellowship / CAPES-Print Program. The FGV Sao Paulo Law School’s Post-Doctoral Program is open to candidates who have recently completed their doctoral degree and whose research interests are aligned with the “Law in the Digital Age” field.

The Program provides early-career researchers the opportunity to develop their academic skills by providing an interdisciplinary and diversified academic environment. Moreover, it promotes additional training in research methods and writing through monthly seminars conducted by FGV Law School professors.

The Post-Doctoral Program aims to stimulate researchers to take part in international and interdisciplinary research networks and expand the frontiers in the “Law in the Digital Age” research agenda.

The International Cooperation Project “Law in the Digital Age” has as its main objective to examine the impact of new technologies and social and economic transformations in the legal professions and in the organization of legal institutions, a topic related to the Program's area of concentration and transversal to the research agenda Program’s Centers and Research Groups. We welcome applications exploring the project’s subtopic on “Rule of Law and Authoritarian Legalism”, which seeks to analyze how political leaders and their governments use technology and law to erode democracy, and how technology and law can be mobilized to resist these movements and strengthen democracy, both nationally and transnationally.
